DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

1. Start with one gallon of water per 10,000 gallons of water. Add 1/2 ounce of Vortexaid to each 10,000 gallons of water. Wait 30 minutes before swimming. For maintenance, add 1/4 ounce of Vortexaid to each 10,000 gallons of water every 3 days. For shock treatment, add 1 ounce of Vortexaid to each 10,000 gallons of water. Wait 24 hours before swimming. Do not use in hot tubs or whirlpools.

DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE FOR HOME WELL WATER SYSTEMS

1. Add 1/2 ounce of Vortexaid to each 100 gallons of water. Wait 30 minutes. 2. Add 1/2 ounce of Vortexaid to each 100 gallons of water. Wait 30 minutes. 3.
