**DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION**

For new pools, for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one (1) part of this hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. Maintain a residual level of 1.0 ppm.

For existing pools, maintain a residual level of 1.0 ppm. Add 1/2 part of this hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water. Frequency of addition will vary with pool size, temperature and bather load. Maintain a residual level of 1.0 ppm.

**DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE  
FOR HOME WELL WATER SYSTEMS**

To disinfect a well, pump water into the well at a rate of one (1) part of this hypochlorite solution for each 100 gallons of water. Maintain a residual level of 0.2 ppm for 24 hours. Flush the well with water until the residual level is at least 0.2 ppm and the water is clear. Test for coliform bacteria as determined by a DPD method.

NOTE: This product is not intended for use in drinking water.

**DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT**

Use a solution of one (1) part of this hypochlorite solution for each 100 parts of water. Immerse equipment for 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with water. Do not use on food contact surfaces.
