PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of mist. Avoid contact with eyes. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands after handling. Do not contaminate feed, water or foodstuffs. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED - Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
IF INHALED - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.
IF ON SKIN - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
IF IN EYES - Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents Under Pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container or throw into fire. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Use at least one canister for each 10,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured.

IMPORTANT:

Locate fogger in center of room or area to be treated. Place newspapers under fogger unit and for 3 or 4 feet around the can to prevent staining or marring of surfaces. Close doors and windows. Remove pets and cover or remove fish bowls. Cover or remove exposed foods and dishes. Open cabinets and doors to areas being treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Place at least 6 feet away from pilot light. Keep at arms length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. To start fogging action, press plastic tab on valve down until it clicks. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave undisturbed for at least 2 hours. Before reoccupying, open doors and windows and thoroughly ventilate for at least 30 minutes or longer.

NOTE: This product may not control hidden crawling insects. It will kill only those insects that come in contact with the mist. Therefore, complete control of an infestation of these crawling insects may not be achieved.

Solvents may soften some asphalt or synthetic tile floors. If used directly over asphalt or synthetic tile, newspaper should be spread on the floor for several feet around the area of release. Do not use with freshly waxed floors, allow wax to become hardened. Some plastics may be affected. Remove or cover plastic items such as eyeglasses, stereo covers, notion boxes.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
