Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of eye contact, immediately flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly after handling.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not let the liquid come in contact with susceptible plants, such as vegetables, flowers, fruit trees, ornamentals, cotton, grapes, or other desirable plants or allow spray mists to drift onto these plants. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift) Thoroughly clean spray equipment before using for other purposes. Do not apply to areas underlain by roots of desirable trees and shrubs.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**General Weed Control**—Weed Killer Concentrate can be used to control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-cropland areas such as loading ramps, fence rows, railroad sidings, storage yards, parking lots, around buildings and industrial plant sites.

To control annual weeds and grasses such as foxtail, rye grass, wildoats, crabgrass, cheatgrass, broomsedge, ragweeds, lambsquarter and turkey mullein, dilute one gallon of concentrate to 9 gallons of water and apply 5 gallons of the diluted spray per 1,000 square feet.

For hard to kill perennial weeds and grasses such as johnson grass, salt grass, bouncing bet, bracken fern, horse tail, smooth brome, canada bluegrass, purple-top, quackgrass, broomsedge, aster, dandelion, dog fennel, goldenrod, plantain and wildcarrot, dilute one gallon of concentrate to 9 gallons of water and apply 10 gallons of diluted spray per 1,000 square feet.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store this product only in original container. Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children. Always keep containers tightly sealed. Avoid storing in area where temperatures would exceed 130° F.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** If container is damaged, turn container on side with damaged area elevated so material will not leak out. If necessary, transfer material to a new, clean container. Mark container with new label. Wipe up any spilled product and dispose of properly. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instruction, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
