Direct nozzle of thermal applicator toward the upper corners of the room and along the ceiling. Close off room for at least one half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary. THERMAL APPLICATIONS OUTDOORS: For reduction in annovance from flies, mosquitoes, gnats, roaches, ants, and spiders in yards, patios, around swimming pools, drive-ins, and horse stables, and other small area applications. Use only in horse stables where horses are not intended for food. Hold thermal applicator at least 5 feet from any object, especially plant and shrubbery. Avoid wetting any plant foliage. Apply undiluted at the rate of 3-3/4 gallons per acre. Fog only when there is no breeze, or the wind velocity is less than 3 miles per hour. The ideal time is generally at dusk when the wind dies down and the air temperature and ground temperature are approximately the same. Under these conditions the fog will linger in the treated area for a longer time. Apply fog while moving away from treated area. Avoid inhalation of the fog. Do not enter the treated area until the fog has dissipated. Repeat application as necessary.
