

## STAF HOSPITAL SPRAY DISINFECTANT

This product has been designed specifically for Homes, Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Institutions, Offices, Schools, Motels and Hotels as a disinfectant, deodorant and air refresher. It is recommended for disinfectant of telephones, bed springs, door knobs, linen carts, hampers, wheel chairs, light switches, garbage pails and other clean inanimate hard non-porous surfaces.

In addition, this product deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling (such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, rest rooms, shower stalls and other areas which are prone to odors caused by micro-organisms).

When used as directed, this product demonstrates effective disinfection against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*.

This product is fungicidal against Pathogenic fungi (*Ascheles Foli Fungus*), when used as directed on hard surfaces found in the bathroom, shower stall, and locker room, or other clean hard non-porous surfaces commonly contacted by the bare feet.

**MOLD AND MILDEWSTAY:** This product prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces when used as directed.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SURFACE DISINFECTION AND DEODORIZATION:** (1) First remove soil deposits from surface to be treated. (2) Hold can six inches from surface and spray until completely wet, allowing the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

**AIR DEODORIZER AND AIR REFRESHER:** Point upwards to center of room and spray for three seconds.

**MILDEWSTAY:** To control mold and mildew on hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops), spray the surfaces to be treated, making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**WARNING:** Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Flammable! Contains under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 120°F may cause bursting.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available drink large quantities of water. Call a physician. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measure against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
