DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with this labeling
Shake well before using. Always hold can upright while spraying.

ANIMAL QUARTERS AND INDOORS: Spray localized areas of living quarters, bedding and other infested areas indoors, such as floors, floor coverings, along and behind baseboards, windows and door frames. Where possible, contact as many insects as possible. Spray into cracks and crevices where ticks may be found indoors. Allow all areas to ventilate for 15 minutes before allowing children and pets to reoccupy area.

FOR USE ON DOGS AND CATS: Hold can 6 to 8 inches away from the pet. Begin spraying at the tail, moving the can rapidly. Make sure the entire body of the pet is covered, including the legs and under the body. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin.

Spray at the rate of 20 to 30 seconds for a 25 pound pet. Spray 5 seconds for a 5 pound cat. Repeat treatment as needed, but not more often than once every 7 days.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after using. Do not spray on birds, or around fish ponds. Do not spray into pet's eyes, face, scrotum or open wounds.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Atropine Sulfate is antidotal. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Content under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.
