 - b. Increase the value of your active ingredient content to meet the 15,00% label claim.
2. The storage stability data you have submitted are acceptable as interim data, but a one-year room temperature or warehouse condition study is necessary to fulfill this requirement.
3. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 4446-30" to your label before you release the product for shipment.
4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

With slow sweeping motion, slightly moisten surface. Saturation is not necessary. To apply to face, spray into palm of hand and rub face. Avoid contact with eyes or lips.

FOR CLOTHING: Spray clothing where insects are biting through, such as around the shoulders and neck area. For ticks and chiggers also spray pant cuffs, socks and around openings in outer clothing. Will not damage nylon, cotton, and wool. Should not be used on rayon and dyne.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.
