DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read all directions before using this product. It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Remove protective cap, point spray valve in direction of arrow. Press remove button to spray. Hold can 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing while spraying. With slow sweeping motion, slightly moisten surface. Saturation is not necessary. To apply to faces, spray into palm of hand and rub face. Avoid contact with eyes or lips. **FOR CLOTHING:** Spray clothing where insects are biting through, such as around opening in outer clothing. Will not damage nylon, cotton, and wool. Should not be used on rayon and dynel. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.
