- b. Provide the flashpoint of the product with the propellant or change the physical and chemical hazards to read:

Extremely Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 °F may cause bursting.

- c. Add the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate" to the storage and disposal statement.

Harmful if swallowed. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, lips or open cuts. Do not expose treated skin or clothing to fire, sparks or flame until liquid has evaporated. Do not allow children to rub eyes if hands have been treated.


3. Submit a complete description of the formulation process. Describe the equipment used, mixing time, temperature, etc.

4. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this Registration Notice.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
