The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Pyrethrins, Permethrin and MGK REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6.

- DO NOT use in a room 5 feet by 5 feet or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before application.
- Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated.
- Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.
- Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared, processed or served.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

This product will kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Rice Weevils, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, Small Flying Moths and Ticks.

Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 9,000 (approximately 25 feet x 45 feet x 8' ceiling) [6,000 (approximately 25 feet x 30 feet x 8" ceiling)] cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units

for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Old bedding should be removed and replaced with fresh, clean bedding after treatment. Pets should be treated with a registered product for flea and tick control in conjunction with this treatment.

DOES NOT CONTROL BEDBUGS

TO USE THIS PRODUCT CORRECTLY: Do not use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Use of a fogger in an enclosed space may cause the product to explode, resulting in injury to people or damage to property. DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames, or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.) Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights. Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.







BEFORE YOU FOG: Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights.





TO START FOGGING: TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Fill out and place hang-tag on the door to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hours. **Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit, or other structure immediately.** Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.



Airing Out: Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two hours. If an odor is still detected additional ventilation is required.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.


