1. Use Enclosure 1 as a guide to revise your "FIRST AID" statement. You only need the "IF ON SKIN" text.


A copy of the stamped label for each product is enclosed for your records.

CAUTION

<p>If inhaled:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move person to fresh air. • If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. • Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
<p>If on skin or clothing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take off contaminated clothing. • Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
<p>If in eyes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. • Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
<p>If swallowed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. • Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. • Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. • Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
<p>Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.</p>

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
FLAMMABLE: Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
 It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, cover all exposed food, food processing surfaces, and utensils during treatment. Do not spray food or feed crops.

For both indoor and outdoor situations, use training whenever possible, including positive (praise) and negative (sharply spoken word backed up with disciplinary action) reinforcement.

This product repels dogs and cats for up to 24 hours when applied daily. Keeps pets away from furniture, carpet, trees, shrubs, garbage cans/bags and other "forbidden areas".

INDOOR USE: To break your pet of undesirable habits such as sleeping on furniture and rugs or to keep out of forbidden areas. Always use with consistent training. Praise your pet for good behavior and scold for bad behavior.

Pre-treatment Directions: Before spraying large areas of rugs, fabric or plastics, test the effect of this product by first treating a small inconspicuous area. This product may stain or soften some fabrics or plastics. To avoid possible damage, spray a piece of cloth lightly and place it on the object or area to be protected.

Application Directions: Spray the object lightly with this product until slightly moistened.

Retreatment Directions: Repeat daily, or as necessary, until undesirable habit is broken.

OUTDOOR USE: Use outdoors to prevent dogs and cats from disturbing flower beds, areas of lawn, trees, shrubbery, fences, patio furniture, and garbage cans/bags.

NOTE: This product is not likely to break the established urination patterns of dogs unless it is used as a training aid.

Pre-treatment Directions: Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where pets have soiled with feces or urine. To discourage repeat visits, remove any droppings and clean with water.

Application Directions: Do not apply directly to foliage of shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants. Do not apply to food or feed crops. Lightly spray surrounding soil or apply to a piece of cloth and affix near area to be protected every day.

Retreatment Directions: Repeat daily, or as necessary, until undesirable habit is broken.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets, away from open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
