CAUTION**

Do not install directly over any food handling or dispensing area. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined. Cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums when in use.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**TO INSTALL:** Install at a distance of seven (7) feet from the floor and where air currents will carry spray throughout room. One unit will treat up to 6,000 cubic feet of air space (a room 30 x 20 x 10) for 30 days, 24 hours a day.

**TO OPERATE:** Remove protective cap and place can in dispenser. Turn on dispenser. The automatic dispenser will dispense 100 mg of insecticide every 15 minutes. Its effectiveness will be noticeable one hour after activation.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

**INGREDIENTS:** Propane-Isobutane (CAS # 68476-85-7), Petroleum Distillate (CAS # 8002-05-9), Insecticide Synergist (CAS # 113-48-4), Piperonyl Butoxide (CAS # 51-03-6), Pyrethrins (CAS # 8003-34-7).
