The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Revise Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Do not get in eyes or on skin.

Move the following statements, as revised, to a subsection of the Directions for Use entitled "General Application Restrictions":

Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, the ill or aged persons are confined. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove exposed food. Do not install directly above or within 12 feet of any food handling or food serving area. Metering devices must be timed not to dispense while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces must be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using. Do not install within three feet of air ducts. Do not use in public places while customers or workers are present. Timers must be set to dispense only during non business hours. Carefully follow directions for the dispenser unit when installing the dispenser and replacing cans or conducting maintenance.

Cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums when in use.

Add at the end of the first aid statements an emergency telephone number that meets the criteria of PR Notice 2001-1.

Move the Note to Physician to the end of the first aid statements.

Revise the installation instructions so that they don't detract from the General Application Restrictions to read as follows:

Do not install directly above or within 12 feet of any food handling or food dispensing area.

Move the information about CAS numbers of the active ingredients to the ingredient statement.

Move the information about the other ingredients to a footnote to the "other ingredients" in the ingredient statement.

The alternate confidential statement of formula dated 4/7/05 referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A copy has been placed in the file jacket for this registration.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

FIRST AID

If Inhaled:

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
- · Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing:

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO INSTALL: Use 12 feet or more from exposed foods. Install at a distance of seven (7) feet from the floor and where air currents will carry cora y throughout room. One unit will treat up to 6,000 cubic feet of air space (a room 30 x 20 x 10) for 30 days, 24 hours a day.

TO OPERATE: Remove protective cap and place can in disperser. Turn on dispenser. The automatic dispenser will dispense 100 mg, of insecticide every 15 minutes. Its effectiveness will be noticeable one hour after activation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed. DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or Liffer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
