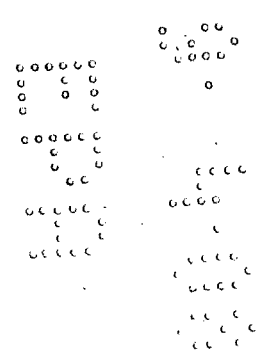

GENERAL APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS: Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, the ill or aged persons are confined. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove exposed food. Do not install directly above or within 12 feet of any food handling or food serving area. Metering devices must be timed not to dispense while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces must be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using. Do not install within three feet of air ducts. Do not use in public places while customers or workers are present. Timers must be set to dispense only during non business hours. Carefully follow directions for the dispenser unit when installing the dispenser and replacing cans or conducting maintenance.

Cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums when in use.
