#### If Inhaled:

- · Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
- · Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

#### If on skin or clothing:

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS: Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, the ill or aged persons are confined. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove exposed food. Do not install directly above or within 12 feet of any food handling or food serving area. Metering devices must be timed not to dispense while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces must be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using. Do not install within three feet of air ducts. Do not use in public places while customers or workers are present. Timers must be set to dispense only during non business hours.

Carefully follow directions for the dispenser unit when installing the dispenser and replacing cans or conducting maintenance.

Cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums when in use.

TO INSTALL: Do not install directly above or within 12 feet of any food handling or food dispensing area. Install at a distance of seven (7) feet from the floor and where air currents will carry spray throughout room. One unit will treat up to 6,000 cubic feet of air space (a room 30 x 20 x 10) for 30 days, 24 hours a day.

TO OPERATE: Remove protective cap and place can in dispenser. Turn on dispenser. The automatic dispenser will dispense 100 mg. of insecticide every 15 minutes. Its effectiveness will be noticeable one hour after activation.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed. DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
