- * Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Wash with soap and warm water after use. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

FIRST AID

If in eyes:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed:

- Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

It reaches fleas hidden in carpet, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet bedding, floor cracks. Protects your home from reinfestation and flea buildup, your pets and family from bites. One treatment with this spray gives continuous flea protection for 120 days. Leaves no objectionable odor or sticky mess and, used as directed, does not stain furnishings.

FLEAS & TICKS: SHAKE WELL. Hold can 2 or 3 feet from surfaces to be treated. Be sure to apply uniformly using a sweeping motion to carpets, rugs, drapes and all surfaces of upholstered furniture. Be sure to treat pet bedding as this is a primary hiding place for fleas.
