To kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets and Bees under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed, spray for about 1 - 2 seconds or until surfaces are moist. To prevent entrance of insects into the house, spray around points where insects can enter house; outside plumbing, faucets, and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges.

Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Do not spray vegetation directly to prevent damage to foliage. If spray accidentally contacts foliage, immediately wash with water.
