Subject: Label Amendment to add West Nile Virus claim
EPA Reg. No. 44446-73
Product Name: Beat-It Insect Repellent Spray
Application date: November 22, 2005

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act section 3(c) (7) (a), is acceptable provided you:

1. Cite or submit additional data or another study with an *Aedes* sp. mosquito vector of West Nile virus. The study you cited included a *Culex* sp. vector of WNV and *Aedes aegypti*, which is not a vector. Submit the requested information within 30 days of the receipt of this letter. The revised data matrix should be accompanied by a letter of authorization to refer to data from the data submitter.

Submit two (2) copies of the final printed label before releasing the product for shipment.

FIRST AID

WARNING

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product provides up to 78 hours of protection from Mosquitoes and up to 4 hours protection from Black Flies, Stable Flies, Sand Flies, Gnats, Chiggers, Fleas, and Ticks. Convenient, easy to use pump spray allows quick and thorough application to skin, hair, and clothing for maximum protection.

Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around eyes. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overapplication of this product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local Poison Control Center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent product with you.

Hold container upright about 4 to 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not spray in enclosed areas. If used on face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not use as a space spray. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to protect all exposed skin. Also, apply to clothing such as shirt, pants, hat, and socks. Frequent reapplication and saturation of clothing are unnecessary for effectiveness. For Chiggers and Ticks, apply to shirt and pant cuffs and socks.


NOTE: Will not damage cotton, wood, or nylon. Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, Spandex or synthetic fabrics, nylon lamure, plastics, waxed crystals, leather and polished or varnished surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
