HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN: Corrosive, may cause severe eye irritation or eye damage. Causes skin irritation. Not intended for use on human skin. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

USES: Floors, walls, metal surfaces, painted surfaces, exterior bowl surfaces, empty basins, instruments, shower, and lavatory fixtures. For institutional use only such as in hospitals and nursing homes, schools and colleges, medical and dental offices, and veterinary clinics.

APPLICATION: Use one ounce of ProQuat 128 Germicidal Detergent per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. For disinfecting, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surfaces. ProQuat 128 Germicidal Detergent is extremely versatile and can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as soaking. The recommended use solution is used once and discarded. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces unless floors are to be waxed or polished.

All instruments are to be cleaned, then immersed in ProQuat 128 Germicidal Detergent solution for ten minutes. Instruments should be rinsed in sterile water before processing for sterilization.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide, or any mixture or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. Do not dump in a safe place away from water supplies.

3. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

For one gallon and five gallon plastic containers, triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place. For 30 gallon and 55 gallon metal containers (a) reuse container and offer for reconditioning or (b) triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill, or bury in a safe place.

4. GENERAL

Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
