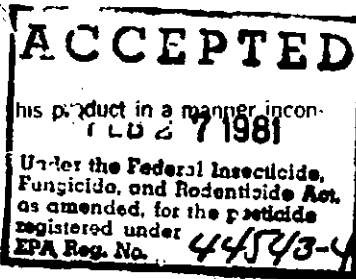

##### SWIMMING POOL ALGAEICIDE

1. In freshly filled pools or pools showing no visible algae growth, add one gallon RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water.
2. If algae growth is observed, add one gallon RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water to kill and control those algae species found in swimming pools. When existing growth is controlled, drain and refill if necessary, and add one gallon RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water.
3. If the pool water treated as in (1) or (2) above shows no algae growth, add one gallon of RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water every 10 to 15 days to maintain between two and five parts per million of active ingredient. See serviceman for test kit.
4. If the pool water treated as in (1) or (2) above is filtered it should be tested periodically to determine the active ingredient content. When necessary, one gallon RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water should be added to maintain two to five parts per million of active ingredient.

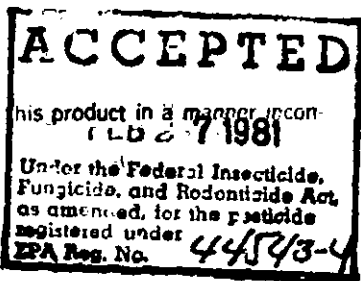

**NOTE:** For maximum effectiveness distribute RB 7000 around pool edges or near pump where it can mix uniformly with water. Allow adequate time for thorough mixing (at least ten minutes). If pool contains a large amount of debris prior to treatment, mix RB 7000 with other chemicals; add directly to the pool.

### DIRECTIONS

#### SWIMMING POOL ALGAECIDE

1. In freshly filled pools or pools showing no visible algae growth add one gallon RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water to prevent algae growth.
2. If algae growth is observed, add one gallon RB 7000 for each 20,000 gallons of water to kill and control those algae species most commonly found in swimming pools. When existing growth is dead, clean the pool, drain and refill if necessary, and add one gallon RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water.
3. If the pool water treated as in (1) or (2) above is recycled, add one gallon of RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water every five to seven days to maintain between two and five parts per million of active ingredient. See serviceman for test kit.
4. If the pool water treated as in (1) or (2) above is not recycled or not filtered, it should be tested periodically to determine the active ingredient content. When necessary, one gallon RB 7000 per 50,000 gallons of water should be added to maintain two to five parts per million of active ingredient.

**NOTE:** For maximum effectiveness distribute RB 7000 dosage around pool edges or near pump where it can mix uniformly into the circulating water. Allow adequate time for thorough mixing before reentering pool (at least ten minutes). Clean pool of debris prior to treatment. DO NOT mix RB 7000 with other chemicals; add directly to pool water.
