## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

### DANGER

Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit. For guidance contact the regional office of EPA.

### PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS STRONG, OXIDIZING AGENT

Strong Oxidizing Agent. Use only clean dry utensils and mix with water only. Mixing other chemicals or gross filth (urine, feces, etc.) will start a chemical reaction resulting in release of toxic gases, heat, and possibly fire. In case of decomposition, isolate container in open air if possible, and flood with large volumes of water.

# WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER

## ACTIVE INGREDIENT:

Sodium dichloro-s-triazinetrione dihydrate... 34%  
(provides 19.1% available chlorine)

INERT INGREDIENTS..... 66%

### PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)

**If swallowed:** Feed bread soaked in milk followed by olive oil or cooking oil. Call a physician immediately.

## RB - WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER

RB - WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER is recommended for use on hard (non-porous) surfaces or on dishes, glasses, food processing equipment or utensils including dairy and brewery equipment or utensils that need a strong sanitizer treatment with little or no cleaning action. This material is very effective on table tops, tanks, vats, floors and walls. It is also very effective on dishes, glasses, metallic utensils and equipment.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dissolve 1 1/2-oz RB - WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER per 10 gal. of water to give a solution containing 200 ppm available chlorine. After cleaning to remove gross filth and heavy soil from surface, apply the sanitizing solution to the surface to be sanitized and let stand 2 to 5 minutes. Rinse well with potable water and dry. The surface is then ready for use.

The same solution may be used in the feed tanks in immersion or spray type machines providing 2 to 5 minutes contact time to sanitizing dishes, glasses, food processing equipment and utensils. Clean and rinse items prior to sanitizing. After sanitizing step, rinse well with potable water and dry. They are then ready for use.

The sanitizing solution should be used promptly after mixing. If the solution is allowed to stand or is reused and tests show the level of chlorine has not been maintained, additional RB - WASH AND SURFACE SANITIZER should be added, to maintain a use solution of 200 ppm available chlorine.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved land fill area or bury in a safe place.
