Germx M mixes with water to form clear, stable use solutions. Use solutions are non corrosive and non-staining to plastic, vinyl, synthetics, enamel, tile and most common metals.

USE DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR RESTROOMS AND GENERAL DISINFECTION of hard, non-porous surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in industrial areas.

CLEANING. Whenever practical, flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning, use 2 to 8 ounces of **Germx M** per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning, remove suspended soils with a clear water rinse, vacuum pick up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.

DISINFECTING. Before disinfecting, preclean surfaces as directed above. Then, prepare 4 ounces of **Germx M** per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. The disinfecting solution must contact the surface for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired, the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean damp cloth.


