

Hand Sanitizing — In food handling and meat cutting operations: Rinse hands and immerse in a 1 oz. HPI 7900 per 5 gals. of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

Retort Cooling Water — For canning operations — add 1 oz. HPI 7900 per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria

Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization — 1 oz HPI 7900 per 10 gallons of drinking water.

Shoe Bath Sanitizer — To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of HPI 7900 for 30 seconds prior to entering area.

1 oz. 4 gal. HPI 7900 for 50 ppm. Approved for Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1978. Recommended by Public Health Services in waters up to 800 ppm of hardness as CaCO₃, when evaluated by the AOAC Germicidal and Disinfectant Method against Escherichia coli and Staphylococcus aureus. The udders, flanks and teats of dairy cows can be sanitized by washing with a solution of 1 oz. HPI 7900 in 4 gallons of warm water. No Potable water rinse is required. Use a fresh towel for each cow. Avoid contact of product sanitizing solution with dirt and soil. Do not dip used teat caps into sanitizing solution. When solution becomes visibly dirty, discard and provide fresh solution.

Directions for Use

Apply HPI 7900 with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surface must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty

HPI 7900 is a proven "one-step" cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-deodorizer in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil and 400 ppm hard water

Disinfection — Hospitals, Veterinary Clinics, Other Health Care Institutions, Institutions, Industry, Schools, Farm Premises and Poultry Houses:

Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon HPI 7900 to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, tile, porcelain, sinks and bedframes. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required

For farms and poultry use, prior to disinfection, all poultry, other animals and their feeds must be removed from the premises. This includes emptying all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Remove all litter and droppings from floors, walls and other surfaces occupied or traversed by poultry or other animals

After disinfection, ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, or other animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.

Sanitizing — Meat and food processing equipment and utensils: Remove heavy soils by flushing, scraping, or mopping. Wash with 1 oz. per gallon of HPI 7900 (or other good cleaner). Rinse with clean water and sanitize surfaces with 1 oz. HPI 7900 per 5 gallons of water (25 ppm titratable iodine). Surface should remain in contact with solution for 1-2 minutes. Drain well and air dry. No potable water rinse is required
