It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

ON ANIMALS: To protect animals from house flies, mosquitoes and lice, apply a fine mist sufficient to wet the top of the animal. To control stable flies, horse flies, horn flies, apply 2 ounces per adult animal to wet the hair, but not to soak the animal. Repeat treatment once or twice daily as necessary to give continued protection.

To control blood-sucking lice, apply the spray lightly to infested areas, and repeat treatment to get the spray to the base of the hair. Apply 2 ounces or less per animal every 2 or three weeks as required.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty containers. Dispose of in several layers of newspaper or other suitable trash.
