DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is intended for use on dogs and cats.

Apply powder liberally to body of animal, working in dust by rubbing against the lay of the hair until dust penetrates to skin. Repeat once weekly if necessary. Contact ticks with powder. **DO NOT** use this product on pregnant animals.

For kennels and living quarters, dust bedding and floor at the rate of one ounce per fifty square feet of surface. Repeat as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting if vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Administer artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate cholinergic inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal.
