

Directions For Use

Mix 1 gal. Aphid-Pruf with 4 gal water Per acre and apply as a foliar spray. For best results, apply on a warm sunny day between noon and 3 PM and when wind speeds are low.

Use when aphid numbers are averaging 50 per leaf or less, and before build-up of honey dew.

Can be mixed with most farm chemicals except those containing either phosphorus or sulfur.

Use stainless steel or plastic tanks, tubing and nozzles. Cone or fan nozzles are best. Do not use fine screens.
