**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate use of gastric lavage.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

SPRING CLEAR algicide is a calm and stable in use dilutable with most chemicals. It is safe for use in outdoor spa and hot tub water. It does not damage tile, concrete, metal, or other materials. It keeps pool and outdoor spa water clear and sparkling clear. It removes slime and green-brown color. It is safe for filter operations and cuts down on the use of other chemicals. It imparts a "feel" to swimming pool water.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label.

**GENERAL:** To control nonattacking green algae. Apply to water after cleaning the pool. For hot tubs containing heavy algae, should be cleaned prior to treatment. Results are obtained with one application and with circulating device. Allow adequate time for water to recirculate before reentering the pool tub (at least 15 minutes). Without fail, even when pool is not used. Do not use in hot tubs if not used. Do not use in hot tubs if not used.

**SWIMMING POOLS**

**INITIAL DOSAGE:** To a clean pool, 1 to 5 gallons per 1,000 gallons of water. If pool shows visible algae growth, double dosage.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** Use 1 to 2 gallons of water every 7 days.

**OUTDOOR SPAS AND HOT TUBS**

**INITIAL DOSAGE:** To a freshly cleaned outdoor spa or hot tub, 1 to 5 ounces per 1,000 gallons of water. If outdoor spa shows visible algae growth, double dosage.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** Add 3 to 4 ounces per 1,000 gallons of water or 5 to 7 days.
