The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. A statement of Practical Treatment is required to appear on your label similar to the following:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Immediately contact Physician or Poison Control Center if swallowed. If eye contact occurs, flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

b. Add the following precautions to your Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals section of the label: "May cause eye irritation. Avoid eye contact. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs."

c. Your storage and disposal statements must be in compliance with PR Notice 83-3.

2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Using portable blowers, apply BORON#101 into cracks and crevices behind stoves, cabinets, sinks, refrigerators, dishwashers, on water pipes and at any holes in the floor or baseboards. Remove all lower cabinet drawers in kitchen, bathrooms and closets and apply BORON #101 liberally into drawer wells.

The average 9 room house will require approximately 12 ounces of BORON#101 with an additional 12 oz. for the garage and basement for a thorough treatment. Repeat monthly or as needed.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS:

Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared, or served, FOOD AREAS APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY.

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) also would be considered a food area.

Apply a small amount of BORON#101 directly into cracks and crevices using a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment capable of applying insecticide directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches hide.

NON FOOD AREAS: Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto surfaces which are exposed or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.
