
i. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for acceptable Storage and Disposal statements for the larger size containers you propose to market (5-gallon and 55-gallon containers).

DISINFECTANT, CLEANER DEODORANT

USE DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR RESTROOMS AND GENERAL DISINFECTION: Hard, non-porous inanimate surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in public rooms, offices, pet quarters, and industrial areas.

CLEANING AND DEODORING. Whenever practical, flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning and deodorizing, use 5 to 8 ounces of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning, remove suspended soils with a clear water rinse, vacuum pick up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.

DISINFECTING. Before disinfecting, pre-clean surfaces as directed above. Then, prepare 5 ounces of THIS DISINFECTANT per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. The disinfecting solution must contact the surface for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired, the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean damp cloth.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING OF GARBAGE CANS, GARBAGE TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL WASTE RECEPTACLES AND OTHER GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT. It is especially important to pre-clean, in order for the disinfectant to perform properly. Then apply a wetting solution of 8 ounces of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water.

FOR CLEANING OF WALL, FLOORS AND INDUSTRIAL WORK AREAS use 5-8 ounces per gallon of water. The use of rubber gloves is recommended for personnel doing continuous hand cleaning.

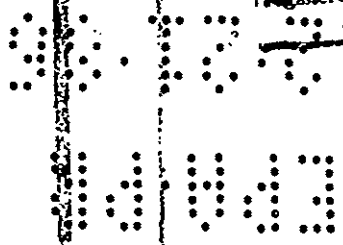
