MAY ALSO BE USED AS A LARVAL KILLER BY SPRAYING DIRECTLY ONTO HEAD OF CATERPILLAR.

**DIRECTIONS:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake can vigorously before use. Insert plastic extender tube firmly into spray nozzle pointing away from you. Hold extender tip one-half inch from cluster, depress valve and use a rapid, circular motion over surface of cluster starting at top. Saturate cluster with Gypsy Moth Zapper. Wear old clothes as Gypsy Moth Zapper will stain clothing. Repeat searches for clusters several times on each tree; you may find additional clusters missed the first time. When using directly on caterpillar, only a small amount is needed to kill. Do not over-apply on young, thin-barked trees such as Birch or Maple. Do not use on porous surfaces such as stone or brickwork or on ornamental trees as it will stain. Do not use when temperature is below 40°F. Use only when wind is calm.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Keep from freezing. To dispose of Gypsy Moth Zapper, wrap container and place in trash.
