Chemfab Algaecide used to control the growth of algae in awimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Chemfab

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 23.5 to 36.4 fluid ounces of Chemfab Algaecide per 10,000 gallions of water and remove sattled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of Chernfab Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4.3 to 8.6 fluid curices of Chemfab Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whiripools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2. to 4 fluid ounces of Chemfab Algaecide per 1000 gallons of water.
