DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Spray infested surfaces until wet. For spot application only. Do not use as a space spray.

Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

Remove pet and cover or remove fish bowls before spraying. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry.

To Kill: Cockroaches Ants Spiders Crickets Silverfish
Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks, crevices, along baseboards, and door sills and frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests flushed out of hiding should be sprayed directly. Treat all trails, nests and points of entry. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To Kill: Carpet Beetles

Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill: Brown Dog Ticks, Indoors

Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of pets, and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after treatment. Do not treat animals with this product.

To Kill: Flies Small Flying Moths Mosquitoes Wasps

For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these pests. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures or porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate.
