For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whiripools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Algaecide "30". For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 23.5 to 36.4 fluid ounces of Algaecide "30" per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of Algeecide "30" per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4.3 to 8.6 fluid ounces of Algaecide "30" per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algoe growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of Algaecide "30" per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whiripool, or hot tub, add initially 1 to 2 fluid ounces of Algaecide "30" per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of Algaecide "30" should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for insintenance.

Algaecide "30" is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH.
