For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Algaecide "60". For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of Algaecide "60" per 10,000 gallons of water and remove sattled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of Algaecide "60" per 10,000 gallons of water.
