The labeling submitted in response to this Agency's letter of March 18, 1985, regarding required labeling for pesticide products containing thiram as one of the active ingredients is provisionally acceptable provided you agree to submit the data identified below.

As there are inadequate acute toxicological data as required under §158.135 of the regulations on data requirements (*Federal Register*, Vol. 49, page 42892) to support the continued registration of the subject product, you must submit acceptable acute toxicological data within 6 months of this letter.

Correct the spelling of "increases" in the alcohol consumption statement.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS  
(AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)**

**WARNING**

Causes eye and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid inhaling of spray mist or dust. Do not use or store near food or feed.

Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Routinely shower or bathe after work and wash all clothing with soap and hot water before reusing. Consumption of alcoholic beverages increase the toxic effects of thiram.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Drift or runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**RE-ENTRY STATEMENT**

Do not reenter treated areas within 24 hours following application unless protective clothing is worn.

Do not rotate treated crop with crops other than those with registered thiram uses.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

1. **PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.
2. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State, or Local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
3. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Dispose of liners according to approved Federal, State, or Local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. If container cannot be reused, dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if permitted by State and Local Authorities.
4. **GENERAL:** Consult Federal, State, or Local Disposal Authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
5. **STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place.

**Statement of Practical Treatment**
