**WARNING**

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

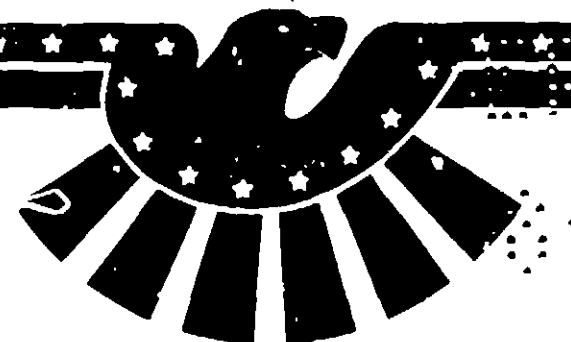
Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

Controls pests on Turf: Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms, Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Hyperodes Weevils. Controls pests on Ornamental Plants: Aphids, Bagworms, Cutworms, Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Mites, Spittlebugs, Exposed Thrips, Whiteflies.

## DIRECTIONS

### LAWN & TURFS.

For control of chinchbugs, sod webworms (lawn moths), ants, brown dog ticks, crickets, earwigs, and grasshoppers infesting lawns and turfs. Thoroughly water immediately after treatment to wash the insecticide into the turf. However, for sod webworm control delay watering or mowing the treated area for 12 to 24 hours after treatment. Dilute spray at the rate of 2 tablespoons per gallon of water to treat 50 square feet or 1 gallon per 125 to 150 gallons of water and apply over 6,600 square foot area. When using a lawn hose-on sprayer (15-gallon to 20-gallon sprayer) fill quart jar to 20-ounce mark with spray and finish filling jar to top with water. Then apply this mixture over 1,000 square feet of lawn grass. Ten steps in one direction and eleven in another direction is approximately 1,000 square feet. Repeat application if chinch bug damage reoccurs or when pests reappear. Keep children and pets off of treated area until spray has dried. Keep out of lawn and garden fishpools and other bodies of water.

### AROUND BUILDINGS:

To help prevent infestation of buildings by ants, crickets, earwigs, and sowbugs (pillbugs), treat a band of soil six to ten feet wide around and adjacent to the building and also the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where pests are active and may find entrance. Dilute spray at the same rate as above. Apply as a coarse (large droplet) spray to thoroughly and uniformly wet the band area.

To control hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils, use 2 gallons spray per 125 to 150 gallons of water and apply over 6,600 square foot area, or 4 tablespoons per gallon of water to treat 50 square feet. Spray suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service Specialist for best time to treat in your area.

### NOTE:

Do not spray vegetable gardens or other plants used for food purposes.

### PEACH TREE BORER:

Dilute this product in water at the rate of 25 oz. of this product per gallon of water. Apply this spray mixture to flowering trees and shrubs of the Genus Prunus as a trunk spray before newly hatched larvae enter the trees. Apply as a coarse, low-pressure spray. Thoroughly wet all bark areas from ground level to scaffold limbs. Consult your Agricultural Experiment Station or Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

### ASH BORER, LILAC BORER, DOGWOOD BORER:

Dilute this product in water at the rate of 7 1/2 oz. of this product per gallon of water. Apply this spray mixture to trunks and lower limbs of trees when the adults begin to emerge. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area. Also controls scale crawlers, Oak lecanium, Pine needle Tip crawlers, and White peach crawlers.

### IMPORTED FIRE ANT:

For the treatment of potted, containerized, balled, or burlapped nursery stock, use 8.9 oz. of this product diluted in 10 gallons of water. For control of fire ants in soil attached to the roots of these plants, completely submerge the ball of soil in a tank containing the mixture. Do not remove burlap wrap or plastic containers with drain holes prior to submerging. Keep soil submerged until complete saturation has occurred, normally about 30 seconds. Wear rubber gloves, boots, and apron during this operation.

### ORNAMENTALS:

To control aphids, bagworms, grasshoppers, mites, spittlebugs, whiteflies. Dilute 2 ounces (4 tablespoons) in 1 gallon of water. Avoid overspraying to the point of excessive runoff. Treat when pests appear and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals if needed. May be used on Shrubs, Vines, Shade and Flowering Trees, and flowers except as noted below.

**NOTE:** Do not use on azaleas, camellias, poinsettias, roses, or variegated ivy because of possible injury to these plants.
