GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Swimming pool water is subject to the buildup of organic contaminants. Sunbather lotion, perspiration and miscellaneous discharges all contribute to this accumulation. These organic wastes should be removed from the pool water periodically. AQUA BURN® effectively reduces organic waste contamination in swimming pool water and restores water clarity.

Add AQUA BURN® at the rate of 1 lb. per 10,000 gallons of pool water. Add total contents of package at one time, by pre-dissolving in a clean bucket of pool water and pouring directly into pool.

AQUA BURN® should be added to pool when pool is not in use. An initial high chlorine reading will result and pool should not be used until chlorine residual drops to between 1 and 3 ppm as determined by a suitable test kit.
