STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

On Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water.

In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists call a physician.

If Swallowed: Drink a large quantity of water and induce vomiting. Get medical attention at once.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air. If irritation persists seek medical attention.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This pesticide is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO KILL FLEAS, TICKS, AND LICE: Dust entire animal beginning at head, being careful to avoid pet's eyes, and working back being sure powder gets down to skin especially around feet and legs. Repeat at weekly intervals if necessary. Dust animal's living quarters freely. Fleas pass part of their life cycle off the dog or cat in dust beneath bedding or cracks and crevices.

DO NOT USE ON PREGNANT OR NURSING ANIMALS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in locked storage areas.

Disposal: Unused insecticide: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Empty Container: Do not reuse can. Dispose in trash.
