DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before using.

Place dog on table or bench. Thoroughly spray all over body against lay of the coat. Avoid spraying into the eyes. The hair should be slightly damp down to skin level.

Repeat treatment as necessary. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas.

Free bitches from fleas before they bear pups.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazardous to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Avoid contact with eyes and inhalation of spray. In case of eye contact, flush eyes with plenty of water. Wash hands after use. Do not use on cats. Do not use on dogs nursing puppies or pups under 10 weeks old.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN AND VETERINARIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

If inhaled . . . Artificial respiration or administration of oxygen may be lifesaving.

If on skin . . . Wash with water.

If on eyes . . . Flush with water, get medical treatment.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
