The labeling referred to above, submitted in connetion with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fulliable and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Under Directions for Use add the following:

INDICATIONS: Ear mites normally cause a dry, dark brown waxy exudate with crusts in the ears of dogs and cats. Mites are easily observed by placing some of the ear wax on a dark surface and watching closely for moving white specks. Do not injure the delicate tissue of the ear. Inflamed, watery or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires services of a veterinarian.

2. Under Precautionary Statements revise as follows:

For animals, discontinue use and consult veterinarian if irritation develops.

Your Confidential Statement of Formula dated September 24, 1992 will meet the label claim for the active ingredient and is acceptable. The change from Mineral Oil to Sesame Oil is acceptable. However, please provide the chemical identity of all components, the percentage composition, CAS Registry Number, and Material Safety Data Sheet (two copies) for Lipovol Ses (sesame seed oil).
