WARNING

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), with one gallon water. Use rubber gloves. Work in well ventilated area. Dip animal in solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Allow animal to dry in warm place without rinsing or toweling. Repeat application every 2 weeks or as necessary.

This concentrate gives long lasting residual control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
