**Statement of Practical Treatment**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by "poking" back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF INHALED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF ON SKIN:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Immediately remove patient from the vicinity of the Methyl Parathion - EPN mixture, remove all contaminated clothing, and wash skin with soap and running water.

**IF IN EYES:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Wash the eyes immediately with running water for at least 15 minutes.

#### DANGER



#### CAN KILL IF SWALLOWED

This product can kill you if you  
swallow it. It is very poisonous.  
Do not swallow it.



#### CAN KILL BY SKIN CONTACT

This product can kill you if touched  
by hands or spilled or absorbed on  
skin. Wash hands and clothing (do not  
wash through clothes).



#### CAN KILL IF BREATHED

This product can kill you if vapors or  
spray mist are breathed.

**DANGER:** Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Repeated inhalation or skin contact may, without symptoms, progressively increase susceptibility to methyl parathion poisoning.

Do not swallow or get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe dust or vapors. Wear clean natural rubber gloves; clean, waterproof protective clothing and goggles. Replace gloves frequently and destroy used gloves. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly The U.S. Bureau of Miners) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provision of 30 CFR Part 11. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking.

Wash clothing before re-use. In case of spillage, wash down with large amounts of water. Decontaminate areas equipment by washing with a concentrated solution of alkali and detergent and rinse with water.

#### ANTIDOTE AND FIRST AID TREATMENT

ATROPINE IS THE EMERGENCY ANTIDOTE FOR METHYL PARATHION - EPN POISONING. Consult your physician about obtaining an adequate supply of 1/100 gram (0.6mg.) atropine tablets for emergency use. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY IN ALL CASES OF SUSPECTED POISONING.

**Precautionary Statements Continued**

**IF WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR:** Take or administer two 1/100 grain tablets immediately. Get medical attention at once. NEVER ADMINISTER ATROPINE UNLESS WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR (See WARNING SYMPTOMS on Have patient lie down and keep quiet. Start artificial respiration immediately if patient is not breathing. Transport the patient immediately to the nearest physician.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN**

**WARNING SYMPTOMS:** Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin-point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps.

**TREATMENT:** Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, atropine sulfate should be injected at 10-minute intervals, in doses of 1 or 2 milligrams, until complete atropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated. Clear chest by postural drainage. Oxygen administration may be necessary. Observe patient continuously for 48 hours. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may, without warning, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until the time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by blood test.

**Environmental Hazards**

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

#### GENERAL DIRECTIONS

VETO can be used in conventional hydraulic sprayers, low-volume ground applicators, or airplane sprayers. For airplane application, use 3 - 10 gallons water per acre depending on crop growth to give good coverage. Use this product only for recommended purposes at recommended dosages. Mix with water by agitation; agitate the mixture while spraying. If allowed to stand, re-agitate before use. Always mix with enough water for sufficient coverage.

#### "Precautions In Using"

Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not apply within 7 days of hand picking or harvest. Workers entering fields within 48 hours after application should wear protective clothing. Do not graze dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter in treated fields.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**INSECT CONTROL ON COTTON:** For control of aphids, boll weevils, cotton leaf worm, flea-hoppers and some species of spider mites, use 2/3 to 1 pint per acre.

For control of Bollworm and budworm, use 1.3 qts. per acre.

For timing of applications, consult your local extension service or State Agricultural Experiment Station. Repeat applications as local conditions warrant.



### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

#### PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:
