STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is intended for use on bare ground in small enclosed industrial areas such as tank farms and substations. Apply a dilution of 2 pints of SODIUM ARSENITE 40% LIQUID SOLUTION to nine (9) gallons of water per 1000 square feet. Areas to be covered by pavement after treatment, dilute 2 gallons of SODIUM ARSENITE 40% to nine (9) gallons of water per 1000 square feet. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift of spray from areas treated. Do not apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label directions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal or approved State procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:
