**DIRECTIONS FOR USE      GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION**

For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one (1) pint (16 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

**FOR POOL MAINTENANCE**

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6-7.2 range and maintain.  
B) Add manually, or by a feeder device, sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (8 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and number of swimmers. Use test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine residual are in the proper range.

**NOTE:** This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. Keep away from fire. Store area with large quantities of water. If necessary, flush thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or dispose of by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved area. Product or residue that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning or equipment.
