**DIRECTIONS FOR
POOL MAINTENANCE:**
For a new pool or for spring start-up, add this sodium hypochlorite solution to 5 ppm available chlorine. For Pool Maintenance:
A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6.
B) Add manually or by a feeder to maintain an available chlorine of 1.0 ppm available chlorine by 1.0 ppm available chlorine will be ppm available chlorine will be. Use test kit to make certain.

**DIRECTIONS FOR
SANITIZING:**
Dilute this sodium hypochlorite solution to 3 parts softened water, 1 part product. Thoroughly and begin feeding of solution and begin feeding of solution. Maintain a free available chlorine level throughout the distribution system. Throughout the distribution system, biological sampling must be conducted. The National Interim Primary Drinking Water Standards must be met with a DPD chlorine test kit. Contact your local Health Department.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING:
Clean equipment in the normal way with this sodium hypochlorite. Maintain contact with disinfectant for after treatment with sodium hypochlorite. (2 lbs/spa) of this solution provide approximately 200 ppm. **NOTE:** This product is a grade 4 as necessary to obtain the results. **STORAGE AND**
