

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is violation of a federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Wet fabrics or diapers should be spin dried before the sanitizer is applied. $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. of FABRISAN 928 should be added for each 16 gallon wash load. Run this solution in the pre-wash, followed by the regular wash cycle with a good detergent. The above application gives 200 ppm available chlorine in the pre-wash cycle.
