1. Replace the internal ingestion statement on the left panel with the wording under "If Swallowed" on the front panel and move the entire statement of practical treatment to its required position on the front panel.

2. Reposition the signal word, "DANGER", as follows:

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

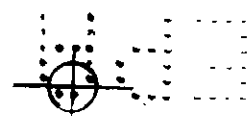
