It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2-7.4. Is determined by test kit. If pH is below 7.0, add appropriate amount of soda ash to raise pH to 7.2-7.4.

2. If the pH is above 7.4, previously, the water should be treated with aeration and the pH adjusted to 7.2-7.4 with the addition of muriatic acid.

3. Add appropriate amount of Aqua Sticks to water. The amount of Aqua Sticks to be added is determined by the amount of water to be treated.

4. Allow the water to stand for 30 minutes. The water should be treated with aeration and the pH adjusted to 7.2-7.4 with the addition of muriatic acid.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat, open flame, and other combustible materials. Containers should be stored upright and away from large amounts of water. Do not reuse empty containers. Rinse empty containers thoroughly with water before reuse. Do not use for drinking water. Do not use for food or animal feed. Do not use for irrigation.
