No. 45309 -// **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label and use strictly in accordance with precautionary statements and directions.

[Spa Clear Algaecide] {or} [This product] is used to control the growth of algae in exterior spas, whirlpools and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, exterior spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

For spas, whirlpools or hot tubs or decorative fountains having just visible growth, add an initial dose of 9 to 13 fluid ounces of [Spa Clear Algaecide] {or} [this product] per 500 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, add initially 5 to 9 fluid ounces of [Spa Clear Algaecide] {or} [this product] per 500 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 5 fluid ounces of [Spa Clear Algaecide] {or} [this product] per 500 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.
